
Our school is scaling new heights with excellent and reputed professionals training our children in a range of co-curricular activities and many more indoor and outdoor games.

"JALLIANWALA BAGH" MASSACRE

The Jallianwala Bagh massacre, also known as the Amritsar massacre, took place on 13 April 1919. A large peaceful crowd had gathered at the Jallianwala Bagh in Amritsar, Punjab to protest against the arrest of pro-Indian independence leaders Dr. Saifuddin Kitchlew and Dr. Satya Pal. In response to the public gathering, the Anglo-Indian Brigadier R. E. H. Dyer surrounded the protesters with his Gurkha British Indian army unit, Sindh Sikh regiment and 52nd Sikh regiment. The troops kept on firing until their ammunition was exhausted. Estimates of those killed vary between 379 and 1500+ people and over 1,200 other people were injured.



The students of JHCS Nagpur had Mushaira as a part of the CCA Competition which was well organized & well reciprocated by the students. Everyone had great fun during the event.







The objective is to orient the students & teachers and provide them with the know-how to become enablers for the entire process and journey of tinkering in schools.






Pot Luck Party

Dining Table Decoration for grade I to V was conducted as a part of CCA Competition.




