
Students were shown the blasting site, Excavation Machines, Transportation unit of coal, underground journey of coal workers, Coal extraction process in today Virtual Field Trip.















One day, the cows had a big quarrel. That day, each one went alone in a different direction to graze. The tiger got the right opportunity. He attacked the cows one by one and ate them up.



Some mothers were waiting for me personally to bring milk packets for their babies and one lady kissed me on my forehead saying that Jeevan ma suna tha bhagwan musibat ma kisi na kisi avtaar ma aate hai madat karne, aaj dekh bhi liya. ! moment that will be there in my brain till I die, says !nkush.

It is not enough to be compassionate, you must act. It is only then that the Earth will turn into a beautiful place. Post Unlock 4, when majority of the public outlets were unlatched, the situation turned grave. With the death toll increasing rapidly and search for oxygen and ventilator bed surging, people again found themselves in dire straits, some like Ankush Bhadange ran amok to aid the distressed.
