Dear students and parents,

We are very happy to share our December edition of school magazine – Phalak. We are looking back at the activities that took place throughout the month of November 2024. Apart from celebrations of special days and events, we also succeeded in completing many partnerships, which are crucial for achieving Academic and Holistic development of your child. CANCER AWARENESS DAY



Kudos to the young environmentalists for their enthusiasm and commitment to making the best out of waste!





CAREER COUNSELLING @JHCS,SP
